Requirements for candidates includes:

1. Meet HASEKO Training Fund and the Construction Training Center requirements:
  - a. Applicants must be a resident of the Ewa/Ewa Beach community.
  - b. Applicants must be 18 years or older.
  - c. Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
  - d. Applicants must be drug-free.
2. All portions of the application must be completed. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure all portions of the application are received prior to the deadline.
3. Applicants agree to follow the CTC Student Code of Conduct and Policies and Procedures.

## **Project ComPACT**

1. Acceptance into Project ComPACT is not a cash award, funds are applied directly to tuition, course materials, and/or books only.
2. All inquiries and applications should be directed to the CTC Project ComPACT that administers the program.
3. Applications will be reviewed and selected by the members of the CTC Project ComPACT Committee. Consideration will be given to career goals, academic achievement, employment history, extra curricular activities, and letters of recommendation.
4. Selected applicants will be notified by mail.
